**GCF&G AT THE ANNUAL BOY SCOUT JAMBOREE**

Dan Accrocco, Grants Chairman, attended the Centennial Celebration of Scouting Jamboree at Fort A.P. in Hill, Virginia, July 26th - August 4th.

He officiated at the Central Region Action Center Trap Shoot Range (one of four at the event). His group of 27 volunteers, with various backgrounds in shooting sports came from ten Midwestern states.

Scouts processed through safety training and shot 20 ga. Remington 870's. The action center served 12,000 shooters and threw 60,000 clay targets during the nine day event.
