You are limited to the range we are using for the match and you cannot stay after the match is over. **Open bolt indicators will be required this year on all rifles**. This is in the interest of safety. The first one will be issued at beginning of season. Replacements will be available for \$.50 each.

To those shooting under the CMP and using club rifles and ammo the following apply: The ammo is allotted in packages of 26 rounds. **If you do not reload or have use for the clips and brass please return them to the van.** The brass and clips are sold later to purchase equipment such as: mats, gloves, scope stands and other equipment.
